1: To turn on the ACE Smart Speaker press and hold the green power button with the PPG logo.



2: Open the Precision Pro Golf app and follow the pairing instructions to connect your ACE Smart Speaker.

3: Listen for the ACE Smart Speaker to chime when successfully paired with your Precision Pro Golf app.



4: Success! Your phone is now paired with the ACE Smart Speaker. Enjoy your music and your round!

LET'S PLAY GOLF



1: In the Precision Pro Golf app, select the "GOLF" Button in the center of the menu.



2: Select the course you are about to play. Press "START ROUND."

LET'S PLAY GOLF



3: Your ACE Smart Speaker will now display accurate GPS measurements to the front-center-back of Hole #1



 Click the green power button for an audible reading of front, center, and back yardages. Use the directional arrows to change holes if necessary.

FIND MY PRECISION PRO



 In the Precision Pro Golf app, select "DEVICES" button on the right side of the menu.



2: Under the ACE Smart Speaker, select "Find My Precision Pro."

FIND MY PRECISION PRO



 The screen will show the location where you were last connected to your rangefinder.



Please Note: Your will need to have first connected your ACE Smart Speaker and will need to have cell service for the feature to function properly.

CHARGING YOUR SPEAKER



1: Your ACE Smart Speaker includes a USB to USB-C charging cable.



 Plug the charging cable into the port located at the bottom of the speaker. Your ACE should have 18-24 hours of battery life when fully charged.

POWERING OFF



1: To turn off the ACE Smart Speaker press and hold the green power button with the PPG logo for seven seconds.



 When the ACE Smart Speaker has powered off you will hear a chime and the LCD Display will be turned off.

ACE PAIRING INSTRUCTIONS



1: Make sure the phone Bluetooth is turned ON and that the ACE is turned OFF.



2: Open the Precision Pro Golf app on your phone and click on the Devices tab.

ACE PAIRING INSTRUCTIONS



3: Tap on the ACE Speaker from the list of devices and tap Connect.



4: Power on the speaker by pressing the green button on the device.

ACE PAIRING INSTRUCTIONS



5: Tap Connect ACE Smart Speaker. Once you have a successful connection, leave the app and enter your phone Bluetooth settings.



6: Locate the PPG - Ace Speaker under available devices and pair the speaker. The speaker will audibly let you know when it pairs.
